

Dear Competitor,

in just a few weeks time, we will meet in Budapest for the World Championship and we are more than thrilled to have you!

To make everything go as smooth as possible and to make sure that you can keep the focus on what's really important - the fun - here are some deadlines and useful information!

The deadline of sending your music to us is the 16th of April. As you might already know, there is a dedicated e-mail address:

If you haven't sent it yet, please do so and please don't forget to send us your national anthem, too!

We listen to every music files from the beginning to the very end to make sure all is all right. This might take a few days but once it's done you will definitely receive a confirmation e-mail from us.

We are also collecting photos for the introductions of all dog-handler duos. If you haven't sent one yet, you can write an answer to this e-mail and attach it. A photo of your routines would be brilliant, but if you prefer another photo, that is also perfect for us!

Please read the following information carefully, some things might need to be taken care of before you start your trip to Hungary!

In Hungary vaccination against rabies is valid only for one year! If you wish to enter the country, you have to make sure, that your dog has a valid one-year vaccine or a 3-year vaccine administered less than a year ago. If your dog received a 3-year vaccine over a year ago, you must have them vaccinated again. Please note that the new rabies vaccine must be at least 21 days old when you wish to cross the border.

Every registered competitor is allowed to bring a plus one, a friend who can support them throughout the championship. Your plus ones do not have to purchase tickets to the event, but they are to stay on the ground floor with you, as the balcony is reserved for paying visitors of the championship. Thank you for your understanding.

No dogs are allowed in the building except for dogs competing at the world championship. Only competitors and their plus ones (and judges) are allowed to bring dogs that are not entered to compete, but if you or your plus one wish to bring your non-competing dog with you, we will need the following data in advance:

Please note that non-competing bitches in heat are not allowed to enter the team area! There will, however, be an appointed area where their crates can be set up in the building.
