

Dear Competitors,

tomorrow the programme of the FCI Dog Dancing World Championship begins with the training day!

Before you first set foot in the venue, we would like to share with you some very last pieces of information.

So far we have received no information, that any of the competing bitches would be in heat. If you compete with a female dog and if she happens to be in heat, let us know!

There will be a dedicated route for bitches in heat, where they can enter and leave the facility without disturbing other dogs. We kindly ask you to turn to us for further information, if this concerns you. You are not allowed to enter the facility if your dog is in heat, without letting us know first. We will help you and we will show you where you can come and go. But if you fail to inform us, you will be disqualified.

You may have noticed that some competitors had to step down, unfortunately. This does not mean any changes will occur in your starting times. Where we are missing a dog-handler duo, there will be a short break. The same applies to the training day. We have now clearly indicated it in the Running Order available on the Facebook Page of the World Championship, pinned to the top for easy access.

If you haven't sent us the order in which competitors representing your country would like to enter the ring to practice on the training day just yet, please do not forget it! We would like to arrange your music files for the sound check in advance to save time.

Just to remind you, sound checks will only be done on the training day. On competition days we will start your music on your signal and at the sound level you choose tomorrow.

We are live streaming the Opening Ceremony starting at 17:50 tomorrow, as well as all three competition days.
